Part 4: Terms & Conditions

1. This study grant is intended to provide educational opportunities to international students who have graduated from high school education at their home country in Year 2009/2010 to pursue selected academic programmes at Taylor's University College / Taylor's College in Malaysia.
2. Study grants on offer are for year 2010 intakes only.
3. This study grant is applicable upon enrolment, subject to student's academic results meeting the entry requirements of the programme and the criteria for this study grant.
4. The study grant shall be in the form of a partial tuition fee waiver.
5. The entitlement of this grant is 30% for the first year and 10% for subsequent years. For American Degree Transfer Program, the grant is in the form of a RM5,000 tuition fee waiver. For Canadian Pre-University, the grant is 30% for full duration of studies.
6. The duration of the study grant is for 1 to 5 years at Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College only.
7. All study grants are applicable for studies at Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College in Malaysia only and are not applicable for period of study at overseas partner universities.
8. The quantum of awards (% tuition fee waiver) to successful applicants is at the sole discretion of Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College.
9. Students are entitled to only ONE of the following – scholarship, bursary or any other financial assistance given by Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College. The highest quantum will automatically apply.
10. All study grants awarded are neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash.
11. The study grant is also subject to other terms and conditions as may be decided by Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College.
12. The terms and conditions of the grant may be modified and amended from time to time as deemed appropriate by Taylor's University College/Taylor's College.
13. Study grant holders must pass all examinations and maintain good academic standards, participate actively in the institution extra-curricular activities in order to maintain their grant status.
14. Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College reserves the right to review grants awarded on a yearly basis. In exceptional cases, a grant may be withdrawn at anytime in the event of gross misconduct or failure to meet the required academic grades.
15. Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College reserves the right to decide on the number of the study grants to be awarded.
16. In the event the student withdraws from the programme before completion, Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College may require the student to reimburse the tuition fee waived.
17. On all matters pertaining to the study grant, the decision(s) of the Bursary Committee of Taylor's University College/ Taylor's College shall be final and binding.
18. All applications must be received by the stipulated deadlines. Late applicants will not be considered.
